CHILDREN'S CHOIRS

GRACE NOTES

Ages 5 & Up
Willingness to listen and follow instructions

ALPHA

1st. Grade & Up
Willingness to participate in movement activities
Ability to match pitch & carry a tune within a group
Appropriate behavior is expected

OMEGA

4th. Grade & Up
Ability to match pitch & sing in head voice
*A great place for singers to enjoy a successful choir experience
without the demands of the Credo & Legacy levels*

CREDO

4th. Grade & Up *(by audition only)*
Ability to sing in tune, blend voice with group,
maintain harmony part alone or with a group
Willingness to accept instruction & read music
High singer commitment level & parent commitment required

LEGACY

6th. Grade & Up *(by audition only)*
Professional Level Youth Choir
Extremely accomplished singing & musicianship skills
Willingness to accept instruction & read music fluently
Rarely misses rehearsals & other scheduled events
Extremely high singer commitment level & parent commitment required
