St. Vincent de Paul Society, a Catholic charitable organization that offers help to all citizens, without regard to religion, was the benefit charity at the December 14, 2008 concert presented by the Community Christian Choir, a multi-denominational choir from Central Jersey. The concert, held at the St. Vincent DePaul Roman Catholic Church in Yardville, NJ, was a festival of contemporary music in the theme of "More Than A Story".

St. Vincent DePaul Society's mission is to aid whoever is in need. Receiving \$1,735.80 in good will contributions during the concert, St. Vincent DePaul Society will be able to help through services such as food programs, rent/mortgage assistance, burial of the indigent and many more.

The Community Christian Choir and its Children Choir division has over 130 members ranging from age 5 to Adult. The members represent over 50 congregations in the Central Jersey region. Having raised over \$115,000 for charity since 1997, the CCC performs only free concerts that benefit local charities.

"Our mission is to share our love of God through Music. It is also to use the talents that have been given to us to help those in need", said Pat Weitz, of Hamilton Square, NJ, CCC director. "We feel we have the best of all worlds, using our voices to praise and help others."

The 27th Season for the CCC begins on April 20th, 2008 with their opening concert, titled "Center-Peace", will be held at The Robbinsville Seventh Day Adventist Church, Rt. 33, Robbinsville, NJ, 6:00 pm.
